1. Describe the pressure Joshua must have felt when the Lord commanded him to lead the Israelites across the Jordan River into the Promised Land. (Joshua 1:1-2)
2. Discuss what the Lord promised to Joshua for his obeying the call to lead the Israelites into the Promised Land? (Joshua 1:3,5)
3. How would you best describe the words “determined” and “confident?” Use personal stories and/or examples to describe what these words mean to you.
4. Why was it so important for the Lord to give rest to Joshua (Joshua 1:13-15)? Why is it so important for us to rest from our labors?
5. Why was it necessary for the Israelites to “deal” with their sin (Joshua 7:13)? Why is it necessary for us to deal with our sin?
