1. God creates something out of nothing.

"In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth."
Genesis 1:1

Created – "Bara" means to bring forth from nothing.

"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new."
2 Corinthians 5:17

2. The Holy Spirit hovers over you.

"Without form and void" means a shapeless, chaotic mass.

"The earth was without form, and void; and darkness was on the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters. Then God said, 'Let there be light'; and there was light."

Genesis 1:2-3

“Hovering” means a vibrant moving, a protective hovering.

Creation “Asah” means making or molding already created matter.
