HELP, I'M FALLING **Genesis 3**

The Road to Ruin

1. What's that thought in the back of your mind?

"Now the serpent was more cunning than any beast of the field which the Lord God had made. And he said to the woman, 'Has God indeed said "You shall not eat of every tree of the garden?"'"

Genesis 3:1

2. Lessen the liberty

*"And the woman said to the serpent, 'We may eat the fruit of the trees of the garden.'" *Genesis 3:2**

*"Then the Lord God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to tend and keep it. And the Lord God commanded the man, saying, 'Of **every** tree of the garden you may **freely** eat.'" *Genesis 2:15-16**

3. Magnify the prohibitions

*“But of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God has said, ‘You shall not eat it, **nor shall you touch it**, lest you die.’”* Genesis 3:3

“But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die.” Genesis 2:17

4. There is no judgment for sin and rebellion.

“Then the serpent said to the woman, ‘You will not surely die. For God knows that in the day you eat of it your eyes will be opened and you will be like God, knowing good and evil.’” Genesis 3:4-5

5. Go for self and bring others also

“So when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree desirable to make one wise, she took of its fruit and ate. She also gave to her husband with her, and he ate.” Genesis 3:6
