**Opposite a life of Generosity is a Life of Greed.**

- **Greed for Money**
- **Greed for Power/Control**
- **Greed for Credit/Recognition**
- **Greed for My Way**

## 4. David's Delight. (I Chronicles 29:9-25)

**Delight is the natural and supernatural response to freedom.**

*"No one can serve two masters. Either you will hate the one and love the other, or you will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and money." – Luke 16:13NIV*

*"Trust in the Lord and do good; dwell in the land and enjoy safe pasture. Take delight in the Lord, and he will give you the desires of your heart." – Psalms 37:3-4NIV*

## 5. David's Death. (I Chronicles 29:26-30)

*"So he died in a good old age, full of days and riches and honor; ..." – I Chronicles 29:28*

*"For David, after he had served his own generation by the will of God, fell asleep, was buried with his fathers..." – Acts 13:36*
