**Icebreaker:** Have you been up to the mountains this winter?

**Read Together:** Ephesians 2:11-22 (NLT)

**Discuss:**

- What do you see in the passage for this section?
- What was God speaking to you as you listened to Pastor Mark speak?
- Who built God's house?
- Why did He build it?
- Who lives in God's house?

**Read Together:** Ephesians 2:14 (AMP)

**Discuss:**

- What does the scripture for this section say that you may not have noticed before?
- Why do denominations exist?
- Do you remember how many Pastor Mark said there are worldwide?
- Jesus is Our Unifying Center Point. What does it mean for us to be a place where people come and feel welcomed?
- What does it mean to have a relationship with God?

**Read Together:** 2 Corinthians 5:16-21 (ESV)

**Discuss:**

- What does the scripture for this section say that you may not have noticed before?
- What is your reconciliation supposed to accomplish?
- You've Been Reconciled to be a Reconciler, are you helping others be reconciled to God?
- How have you seen God be good?

**Read Together:** 1 Peter 2:4-5,9-10 (ESV), Psalm 133:1-3 (ESV)

**Discuss:**

- What do the scriptures for this section say?
- Are you willing to humbly and willingly follow Christ?
- How do we best host the presence of God? (Alone or with other believers?)

**Discuss:**

- **We are called to declare the Goodness of God's character to the whole world through our unity and love for one another.**
- How can you adjust to be in harmony with others?
- In what ways can you actively live out your calling as a reconciler and ambassador for Christ in our daily lives, so that our unity declares God's goodness to the world?

**Pray:**

- Ask God to build His house in your realm of influence.
- Ask God to give you words of reconciliation to offer to people around you.
- Ask God to show you His goodness.
- Ask God to help you be humble and willing to follow Him.
