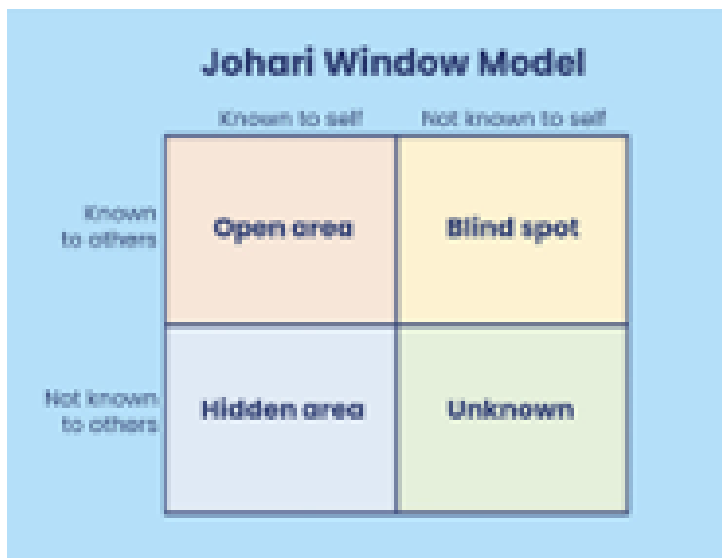
**Icebreaker!** What is your fall activity of choice?

**Review together: Johari Window**



**Discuss:**

- Have you ever heard of the Johari window before?
- What strikes you first as you review the Window above?

**Read together:** Psalms 10:4 (NIV), Mark 7:6-8 (NIV)

**Discuss:**

- You're willing to talk it, but are you really willing to walk out the heart journey?
- What were Hypocrites?

**Consider together:** God Wants to Work In The Whole of Our Hearts, and It Can Mean Facing Some Tough Things.

- What things may He need to challenge or change in your life?

**Read Together:** Psalms 139:1-18 (NIV), Luke 16:15 (NIV), Psalms 26:2 (NIV), Psalms 139:23-24 (BSB), 1 John 3:20 (BSB)

**Discuss:**

- What stands out in the scriptures for this section?
- Where can you go from God's presence?
- What things do you most commonly justify?
- Take a few moments to examine your heart and mind. What does God bring to the surface?

**Pray:**

- Ask God what things He wants to challenge or change in your heart.
- Take a few moments to examine your heart and mind. Talk to God about what He bring to the surface?
- Take a few minutes to pray through the prayer of confession.

**Prayer of Confession**

“Most merciful God,
