- When do you choose to avoid opportunities to love others?
- Share an example of when you were curious about a situation but were not concerned.
- How do you treat others the way you would want them to treat you? Give Examples.

Read Together: Luke 10:33 (NLT), Luke 10:33 (NIV), Galatians 6:2 (NIV)

Discuss:

- What do the Scriptures for this section say that make you see a new aspect of God's character?
- How can you grow in loving those around you?
- How often do you find yourself being mindful of the needs of others?
- How do you put yourself in someone else's shoes?

Read Together: Luke 10:34-35 (NLT), Galatians 6:10 (NIV), Proverbs 3:27 (NIV)

Discuss:

- What do the Scriptures for this section say that make you see a new aspect of God's character?
- What are your typical ways of showing kindness to others?
- What do you think our church would look like if we came into the room saying "There you are!"?

Pray:

- Write down 5 people in your life:
- Ask God to show you the struggles that the people on your list may be going through.
- Ask God to show you what is within your power to do today.
- Ask God to open your eyes to opportunities to love others today.
