Read Together: Exodus 4:1-5 (HCSB), Exodus 4:6-9 (HCSB), Exodus 4:10-17 (HCSB), Exodus 4:18-23 (HCSB), Exodus 4:24-31 (HCSB), Psalm 94:20 (CSB)

Discuss:

- What do the scriptures for this section show you that you have not noticed before?
- What was the Holy Spirit saying to you as Dr. Boot spoke?
- What is God asking you to do that you think you don't have the ability to accomplish?
- What were the signs God Showed Moses?
- What signs has God given you regarding the call He has given you?

Read Together: Exodus 4:11-12 (CSB), Matthew 10:16-20 (HCSB), Jeremiah 1: 8-9 (NKJV), Luke 21:14-15 (CSB)

Discuss:

- What do the scriptures for this section show you that you have not noticed before?
- What were the two Objections Moses voiced to God?
- What if they won't believe me?
- I am not eloquent; my mouth and tongue are slow.

Read Together: Exodus 4:22-23 (NIV), Galatians 5:1 (NIV), 1 Peter 2:16 (ESV), Isaiah 54:17 (HCSB)

Discuss:

- What do the scriptures for this section show you that you have not noticed before?
- What parallels to Jesus do you see in these scriptures?
- What were the freedoms God brought to the People He had chosen?
- What were we set free to do?
- What are the ways God wants you to step out in Freedom?
