From “In the Beginning” to Amen – Job Part 2

Icebreaker: What is your favorite part of February?

Read Together: Job 38:1-3 (NLT)

Discuss:

- What was God speaking to you as you listened to Tim teach?
- What things stand out to you from the scriptures we just read?
- How has God challenged your thinking?
- What are some ways that you have been humbled in God’s presence?

Read Together: Job 38:16 (NLT), Job 39:1-2 (NLT), Psalm 38:18

Discuss:

- What things do you think God would ask us now that we are not in the Bronze Age?
- We are far more knowledgeable. What are some things you are really proud to know?
- What do you think God would ask us today?
- Give an example of a way you have gotten closer to knowing God instead of just looking AT Him.

Read Together:

Discuss:

- What are some things you have thought God owed you?
- What has God offered you that He does NOT owe you?
- “Looking “AT”, doesn’t give us answers “TO”. What things do you look at and assume you know that answers to?
- What things do you look at and realize you have a lot more to learn?

Instead of asking for explanations, find refuge in WHO He is.

Read Together: 2 Corinthians 12:9-10 (NASB)

Discuss:

- What are some ways that God doesn’t treat you as you deserve?
- What are some ways that God has allowed you to see Him with your own eyes?
- How has Repentance led to more intimacy with God in your life?
- Take some time to recognize and name the following:
 1. Recognize God’s Supremacy and bow before him
 2. Recognize God’s Sovereignty and let it be your comfort (He is Good)
 3. Pursue a right view of God and a right view of self (Humility)

Pray:

- Repent of pride and arrogance
- Take a posture of surrender
- Ask God to meet you and show you Himself.
