Dear VCH Partner,

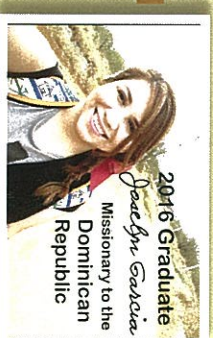

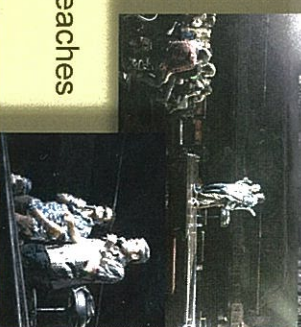
