A few days ago, a very influential conservative news station, published an article about our church's second location, (Uskudar), with the picture and address of our place visible in the front page. And, the newspaper is asking the authorities to stop us from doing what we do.



Although the newspaper is not hugely popular, it is known as one of those news stations that supports extremists, and radical Islamic groups. In the sensitive situation of the middle east and Turkey, this news puts us, and other churches, in a tough situation once again.

Having given the news, while almost ready to send the newsletter (we just need to have our son Elijah check its grammar first :)), we heard of another bombing had just happened a few hundred meters away from the first church, Sancaktepe, killing one person and wounding many.
