God showed her that a believer named Shipval was the one.

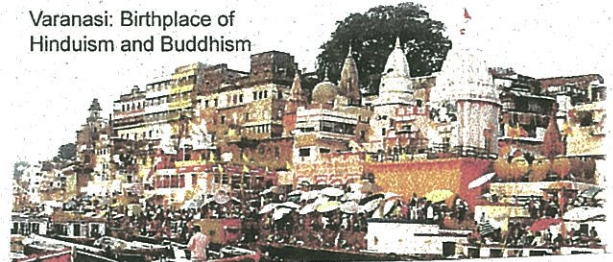
She called him "King David," and he has now...

- ...seen 50,000 children educated in rural literacy centers
- ...initiated anti-trafficking rescue work
- ...seen hundreds of families lifted out of poverty
- ...seen 800,000 new believers and 23,000 village churches planted through the 2020 network

I just received this report..."Our leader in Pakistan sent a note this morning: We praise God for His faithfulness. Our boys are safe and coming home tonight. Thanks for you prayers and support." ...BACKGROUND...On one of our trips to Kazakhstan in the early 1990's, our workers there expressed their desire to start a YWAM base. With your help, we were able to purchase a large house. This facility has been used for conferences, training schools, and housing ever since. They maintain a low profile in all of their activities. PLEASE PRAY FOR THE SAFETY OF THESE WORKERS. ...DEREJE continues to bless the orphans. He just had the kids break 300 eggs into a big cauldron and made omelets for all the kids at a summer camp. He is also spending time with some handicapped orphans. They love him...and cry when he has to leave. PLEASE PRAY FOR HIM.

ALASKA: Barb reports, "We recently graduated our second Modules of Midwifery school. The ladies are prepared to be placed as apprentices with licensed midwives. Our DTS will go to Savoonga, a Yup'ik village on St. Lawrence Island. They will run a mini-DTS for the people there. Next up is a Basketball DTS. Basketball is a great way to connect with Alaska village kids."
